
10th JÁNOS SZENTÁGOTHAI TRANSDISCIPLINARY CONFERENCE AND STUDENT COMPETITION



The Organizing Committee has the great pleasure of inviting you to participate in the Transdisciplinary Conference to be held on the 4th and 5th November 2013 in Pécs, Hungary.

Our eponym **JÁNOS SZENTÁGOTHAI**, born in 1912, was a prominent neurobiologist who was the president of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. He is one of the pioneers of 20th century brain research – in particular he discovered and described the micro-anatomical structure and physiological functioning of the cortical module. In the year 2012 we proudly celebrated the 100th anniversary of the birth of János Szentágothai, honoring his memory by walking in his steps on the path leading to a fuller understanding of the human being - ourselves.

Main aims of the conference:

- 1. debut opportunity for BSc, MSc and PhD students
- 2. provide a field for non-native speakers
- 3. improving language skills

Pécs is located on the slopes of the Mecsek mountains, 200 km away from Budapest. Pécs is one of the most popular tourist destinations in South West Hungary, with sights ranging from mosques as representatives of the rich heritage from the age of a 150-year-long Ottoman occupation, to the Roman Catholic Cathedral and the early Christian Necropolis, which is a UNESCO World Heritage site. In 2010 Pécs has been selected to be the European Capital of Culture, sharing the title with Essen and Istanbul.

Sections

The aim of the conference is to share our pieces of knowledge about the internal and external systems of linkages and relationships we generally consider a human being and therefore it will be organized in the following three sections:

- Medical & Natural Science section
- Social Science & Religion section
- Marketing section

The program will include lectures by invited speakers, oral presentations, and poster sessions. **The official language of the conference will be English**. Presenters are encouraged to submit their papers to be published on the conference's website.
